The ranch spent **\$145,490** in 2020. Here is where your gifts were used (see dollar amounts in right chart):

- ★ Survivor holistic care & support staff (62.3%)
- ★ Equipment maintenance, repairs and supplies (2.8%)
- ★ Property care and development (8.3%)
- ★ Training, development and travel expenses (1.5%)
- ★ Camp Run Free and other event costs (1.7%)
- ★ Animal feed, hay, vet & farrier services (8.0%)
- ★ Website, mailings, marketing and supplies (3.5%)
- ★ Insurance, office supplies and fees (11.9%)
